

Project Title : Comprehensive Sexuality Education Project (CSEP)
Duration : April 2008 to December 2009

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark (DANIDA) in Dec 2007 funded the International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF), central office London to start Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) project in four countries, including Nepal. FPAN have started a Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) project in April 2008. The project aims to move the sexuality agenda forward and develop a new model that will strengthen the evidence-base and further the global agenda on advocating for Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE). The goal of the project is to work towards the integration and implementation of comprehensive, gender sensitive and right based sexuality education through the national curricula (primary and secondary) in Nepal. The project will focus on creation of sustainable advocacy networks through youth involvement to promote CSE and undertake national advocacy/campaigning activities. The project will work with key stakeholders to adopt a broad based sexuality education curriculum and build skills to ensure its effective allocation.

Results/Outputs

1. Established sustainable advocacy network to promote CSE in Nepal
2. Adopted a broad based curriculum and developed skills of key stakeholders on CSE
CSE curriculum will be finalized based on suggestions and feedbacks from different experts
CSE training manual to teacher will be finalized incorporating suggestions and feedbacks received from experts
TOT on sexuality education to master trainers in MOE & MOH and some teachers will be conducted
3. Advocacy campaigns and programs conducted
Undertaking national advocacy campaign through youth on CSE curriculum example: Youth rally
Handing over memorandum by youth to MOE & MOH to endorse CSE curriculum in school
Sexual and reproductive health (SRH) fair (mela)
Interaction and orientation to religious Leaders
Sensitization meeting to parents and teachers will be conducted
Interaction meeting with teachers and students will be done
Broadcasting CSE program once a month through FM, Talk program on CSE on special occasions, Radio Jingles and spots
Advocacy through teachers association on the importance of CSE
CSE will be integrated in other youth programs of FPAN
